This is very much a side business for Huntington Mill and they may discontinue the service if it doesn't warrant their time. She promised that it would promoted it to the machine knit guild. Please spread the word to the other guilds. The shipping is reasonable if you buy in bulk; over \$500 it is free, and they have 10% off coupons when you sign up and usually at holidays.

Colleen can bring swatches of some of the yarn for members to look at before purchasing. It is important to keep sources of mill ends alive for Machine Knitting by supporting and providing feedback to these sources. Hand knitters are not going to even understand how to use these yarns, so it is up to machine knitters to patronize this vendor. All the yarns are made in PA, USA.
