#### **STITCHES UPDATE:**

- 2. The following items are still needed for our booth at Stitches. Please bring to the July meeting or let a committee member (Pat Hendrix, Toni Jokiel, Mack McKernan, or Diane McQueen) know that you will bring them to Stitches on Thursday for set up or will make arrangements for someone to bring them to Stitches for you.
  - a. **Table** 1 or 2 tables for knitting machines (tables, rather than stands, seem to work best for LK150 machines so there is space for tools and yarn on the table)
  - b. **Yarn** for knitting hats or demonstrations suitable for LK150 machines (could also use 2 strands of thinner yarn)

# 3. Garments for display:

- a. Please bring items to the July meeting if possible, or bring to Stitches on Thursday during set up, or drop off at COD (call or e-mail Sharon before bringing to COD, She is usually there on Tuesday and Thursdays from 3-9 p.m. in room C1008.)
- b. Suggested garments: We need a variety of items so we can change the clothing on the dress stands every day.
  - i. Everything sweaters that were knit by several people
  - ii. Scarves
  - iii. Shawls
  - iv. Sweaters
  - v. Children's items
  - vi. Afghans
  - vii. Baby blankets
  - viii. Doll clothes
  - ix. Hats
  - x. Toys
  - xi. Etc.

- c. Label items with the following information: item, machine, yarn, pattern, comments, your name, etc.
- d. Labels will be available at the July meeting if you do not have any.
- e. You can pick up your items at Stitches at 4:00 p.m. on Sunday, August 6, have a friend bring them home for you, or pick them up at the September meeting.
