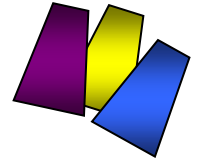

*Knitting a Plated Vest with inset panels (hands-on)**

*The hands on project is a plaited vest using a combination of high-quality linen and bamboo yarns from Silk City. The pattern will be available on Rebekah Younger's Ravelry site for \$8.00 - order directly from the site and download the pattern (more info to follow). Carol Scott will be purchasing the yarn and will make up kits to make the project more cost effective for us. The cost for the kit will be \$34 and will include enough yarn to make the largest size and the small patches. The yarn kits will be available for pick up at the September meeting as you will need to knit the patches for the vest prior to the October seminar so that they can be dyed on Saturday. **IMPORTANT NOTE: Carol needs to know how many yarn kits to make up, so let her know by Sept. 1 if you want one.** You can pick-up and pay for the kit at the September 9 meeting. If you will not be at the September meeting, please make arrangements with someone to pick up your yarn kit or contact Carol at truethreads@aol.com.

If you are only participating in Saturday's "Shake & Bake" dyeing, yarn for that day only will be available for \$3.50 and should also be picked up prior to the seminar.

Participants will receive instructions about knitting your swatch/patch for dyeing on Saturday. If you register after September 9, please email or call Carol Scott at 630-542-7079 to make arrangements to get your Kit or swatch/patch yarn before the seminar so you are prepared to participate.
