

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

Q: Do we bring the knitting machine to the meeting?

A: You do not need to bring your machine to the meeting. The educational portion of the meeting is usually a demonstration of a technique or topic related to machine knitting. We do have a knit-in in November when the members bring a machine in for charity knitting.

(If you have a plastic bed machine i.e. the LK 150 or a Brother 350 may I suggest you check out the LK 150 club. Their meetings are hands on.)

Q: I have a knitting machine at home that I haven't used in a long time. Will someone help me learn how to use it?

A: Many of our members are very experienced machine knitters and are usually quite willing to help people get started again. But please don't bring machine to the meeting unless you have talked to a member and they told you to bring it.

Q: Do I have to be a member to attend a meeting?
